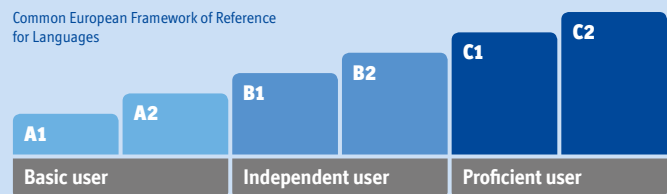

The Carl Duisberg Training Center Munich is situated in the West of the city not far from the city center and is easily reached by public transport. ## Carl Duisberg Training Center **Radolfzell**



The Carl Duisberg Training Center Radolfzell is situated directly at the town gardens with a view of the historic district. This peaceful building was built in 1903 and within its walls you can very quickly feel at ease and find friends from all over the world. This small, very personal school has eight classrooms, a small cafeteria, a computer room and a basement party room. Many participants stay in small groups in the guest house suitable for students.
